

Dear Sir,

Re: The Kebab House 5 Church Street Romsey

I wish to lodge an objection to the granting of a licence to sell hot food after 11p.m at these premises.

I refer to previous correspondence regarding these premises and remind you that I have already sent you a summary of a residents meeting that was held with Inspector Funnell at the end of October, to discuss anti social behaviour in the area surrounding these premises particularly late at night.

When the drinkers leave the pubs drunken adults descend on the Kebab House for take away food, the remains of which are scattered about even onto the roof of cars and scattered through the Abbey Arcade.

Windows in shop premises have been broken this year in Church Steet and damage has regularly been caused to the public convenience in Lortemore place as well as urinating in the litter bins, scuffles or all out fighting and the accompanying foul language.

Many residents in this area are elderly and one 91 year old's garden has been regularly targeted by drunks. The only reason these anti social people come to *Church Steerisstantood formitke Kakah Ruse and they* their walk through the Arcade down to Latimer Street and presumably back to their homes.
