

**Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions**

**Section 21 - Mandatory Condition: Door Supervision**

- (1) Where a premises licence includes a condition that at specified times one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity, the licence must include a condition that each such individual must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
- (2) But nothing in subsection (1) requires such a condition to be imposed:
- (a) In respect of premises within paragraph 8(3)(a) of Schedule 2 to the Private Security Industry Act 2001 (c.12) (premises with licences authorising plays or films), or
  - (b) In respect of premises in relation to:
    - (i) any occasion mentioned in paragraph 8(3)(b) or (c) of that Schedule (premises being used exclusively by club with club premises certificate, under a temporary event notice authorising plays or films or under a gaming licence), or
    - (ii) any occasion within paragraph 8(3)(d) of that Schedule (occasions prescribed by regulations under that Act).
- (3) For the purposes of this section:
- (a) "security activity" means an activity to which paragraph 2 (1)(a) of that Schedule applies, and
  - (b) paragraph 8(5) of that Schedule (interpretation of references to an occasion) applies as it applies in relation to paragraph 8 of that Schedule

**Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule if any appear below**

**Notice shall be given to the Police at least 7 days before the premises intends to remain open later for College Bop nights.**

**A minimum of two SIA registered door staff shall be provided on Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Bank Holidays and College Bop nights between 2300 and 0300 hours. At closing time the door staff are to be supplied with a reflective garment to wear and to assist with the dispersal of customers both within the premises as well as any congregating on the pavement/road directly outside.**

**A suitable CCTV system needs to be installed within the premises. This needs to capture images of customers as they enter the premises as well as having good coverage of the shop floor itself. The CCTV must be operational at all times when the premises are open to the public. Tapes of the images recorded must be retained for 14 days and made available to the Police on request.**

**In addition to clearing the refuse from outside of the shop after closing time, the licence holder must take all possible steps to ensure that adequate facilities are made for collection and disposal of refuse.**
