We are writing regarding the above proposal
printed in 'The Andover Advertiser' dated 31st March 2006.
We would like to object to this proposal, because,
firstly, the premises do not currently open 24 hours
daily. If they did this would infringe on our human
rights by increasing noise after the current 10pm closure.
It is positioned in a built up residential area
and would therefore put children at risk from
people abusing the availability of alcohol, and also
increase traffic in the area.

We also think that it would increase
crime because of this availability and the effects
of alcohol. The hospital is in this area as is a
pharmacy, which could be the target of break-ins.
Also Butons up off licence is in the area which has
been a target for numerous break-ins over the
last few months.

It would also encourage people, after vacating pubs etc. after closing time, to the area to purchase more alcohol and create a nuisance from noise, and also litter which is already a problem. This would further enhance this problem.
