We would like to make a representation in relation to this application.

We would like to object to any increase in hours for the premises and licensable activities.

The reason for the objection being that the premises is in a residential area and would cause noise pollution and disturbance to the residents.

The area outside and near the Borough Arms is already gaining a reputation for being a trouble spot for the police, who are regularly called due to disturbances. Extending the licensable activities for The Borough Arms at any time in the week would make this one of the few premises in the area allowed to open so long and so would attract activity into this residential area until unreasonable hours.

There are other licensed premises in the area, if the extension of licence was granted they would probably apply for this increase, which would also be detrimental to the residents.

We moved to the area after The Borough Arms was established and so expected a small amount of activity due to the premises, but over the past 2 years the disturbances have been getting greater, especially the loud music, which at times prohibits our sleeping and at other times prohibits us using our garden in relative peace and at other points the groups of people causing disturbances nearby.

An increase to the licensing at any time of the week would not decrease this, but only serve to increase it.
