**NOTICE OF MAGISTRATES' DECISION UNDER S.165 LICENSING ACT 2003**

A senior police officer of the Hampshire Constabulary made a Closure Order under S.161 of the Licensing Act 2003 on 14<sup>th</sup> December 2006 in respect of

**THE CLUB AT LIFE AND THE PUB AT LIFE,  
12, London Street,  
Andover,  
Hants  
SP10 2PA**

because he reasonably believed that the grounds in section 161(1)(a) of that Act existed.

The Magistrates' Court sitting at Andover has today considered the Closure Order and is satisfied that closure of the premises is necessary in the interests of public safety because of disorder or likely disorder on the premises, or in the vicinity of and related to, the premises.

It is ordered that the premises are, subject to the conditions below, to be closed until such time as the relevant Licensing Authority has made a determination in respect of the closure order for the purposes of S.167 of the Licensing Act 2003.

Conditions referred to above:-

1. That no entry or re-entry to the Club at Life or the Pub at Life shall be permitted after 12 midnight.
2. That no army personnel shall be permitted entry at any time.
