RE: LIQUOR LICENCE APPLICATION – FORMER SCATS STORE, WEYHILL ROAD

In relation to the above application we would like to make comments concerning this matter.

We have, reluctantly, got used to the fact that Tesco Express will start trading at the former SCATS store on 30.11.07, apparently with or without a licence.

Before agreeing this licence application we would like our following points to be considered and acted upon.

1. All the other stores in the vicinity have liquor licences only up to 10.00pm at night – why does Tesco need longer?
2. The amount of noise pollution and light pollution this will cause and having to endure more car petrol/diesel fumes. They will also use our road to park in. Having a Tesco Express store so close to our neighbourhood, trading not only in liquor to 11pm at night will also jeopardise any sleep/peace we would like. SCATS only traded from 8.30 am to 5.30 pm, so this is a complete change in trading circumstances.
