- 9. The Nisa store further along the Weyhill Road
- 10. The Tavern pub on the corner of Millway Road
- 11. The Shell Garage, Weyhill Road

There are no complaints about these establishments but to add another outlet clearly there appears **no need** except for the commercial aspect. It is also felt that as we have a constant problem of under age drinking and PCO and beat officer plus working with the Housing providers in the area another outlet really is not required

If allowed would further cause problems as these existing outlet on the whole know the local offenders and the young people are aware of this

I would strongly on behalf of my constituents object to a licence being approved. I am also aware the local ward members are also concerned.

I would urge the committee to listen to the CPO and Ward members and the local beat officer. We have now had the vandalism, the other offences that occurred on a regular basis reduced dramatically as we have had the cooperation not all concerned by adding another outlet this will undo all the good work and with high percentage of elderly people in the area.
