Relevant Offence details: Convicted on 12/10/2005 at Southampton Magistrates Court for the offence of driving a motor vehicle with excess alcohol (contrary to section 5 of the Road traffic Act 1988). Fined £300 plus £51 costs. Driving licence endorsed and disqualified from driving for 16 months reduced by 4 months if by 12/08/2006 drink drive course completed.

NB This conviction becomes spent 5 years from the date of conviction.

Police objection notice: Hampshire Constabulary have an objection to the application of a personal licence to be granted to Mr Alan ARTHUR.

We feel that Mr ARTHUR'S conviction undermines the Prevention of Crime and Disorder objective.

The conviction shows that Mr ARTHUR knowingly drove his car while under the influence of alcohol which resulted in breaking the law. To our reckoning this shows that Mr ARTHUR may knowingly commit a relevant offence regarding the Prevention of Crime and Disorder objective of the Licensing Act 2003 in the future.
