Dear Sirs

I understand that a license has been requested for Rownhams House.

I wish to object to it on the grounds that Rownhams House is in the middle of a residential housing estate.

Access to it is via narrow residential roads, and the grounds are too close to neighbouring houses. Alcohol generates noise and rowdy behaviour, which in the middle of a housing estate is unacceptable, especially late at night, when this license would be used. This would then be followed by vehicles leaving the estate, which would involve doors slamming at the very least, and accidents/damage to parked vehicles being a distinct possibility. This is not wanted when young children are trying to sleep.

A previous, unlicensed, event at these premises resulted in such disruption, (although no accidents, fortunately) so this is not just speculation. If a license had been available I fear the disturbances would have been much worse.
