I wish to make representation in connection with the application by Mr and Mrs Barber for the new grant of a Premises Licence for Rownhams House, Rownhams, Southampton.

I feel that such an application is totally unsuitable within a compact residential area such as this.

The sale of alcohol is a particular worry. One knows from experience with the local youth in the area that this can be a problem especially at weekends and the ability to purchase more alcohol locally will certainly exacerbate this.

Clearly regulated entertainment with associated alcohol consumption would add to more noise and rowdyism.

I notice the phrase 'late night refreshment'. How late? It is very likely that it would be much too late for local residents!

There would obviously be a considerable increase in traffic within the area. Again unacceptable.

To sum up: My feelings are very strongly that this application may suit Mr and Mrs Barber, but for all the other residents in the Rownhams area it is very bad and worrying news and I hope it will be dismissed forthwith.
