Re application for premises Licence, Rownhams house,

Rownhams Southampton.

I am a resident that lives directly adjacent to the driveway to Rownhams House and was appalled to hear of the above proposal.

We moved to Rownhams for the relative peace and quiet away from commercial and social premises of the Town and feel we have a number of legitimate reasons for opposing the above application.

My main concern is that of noise pollution when party revellers are arriving and departing the premises late at night and congregating at the bottom of the Rownhams House driveway... directly in front of my house and bedroom window. The noise of car doors slamming will be particularly noted late at night as this is an exceptionally quiet area.

We have grave concerns about crime as this would most certainly increase as a result of an alcohol late licence being granted, with properties in the vicinity being vandalised etc and cars being damaged. There would certainly be the need for extra policing.

There would almost certainly be a considerable amount of additional traffic in the area and parking problems. The neighbourhood is not geared for this sort of activity and illegal parking i.e. parking on grass verges etc would become a problem this could cause a danger for pedestrians.

Changes in the usage of the above premises could be severely detrimental to the Rownhams neighbourhood and hope that the application will be considered very carefully in view of these strong objections allowing the residents to live as they had anticipated in a quiet residential area.
