I wish to oppose this application, which I hope will be refused.

This is a quiet area of Rownhams, and the prospect of late night noise and disturbance from music, patrons or activities associated with events such as wedding parties or theatrical productions not to mention many more vehicle movements, slamming car doors, and potential overspill of parking onto neighbouring residential roads would be totally unacceptable.
