

Thank you for your letter dated 23/4/9.

With regards to the four licensing objections here's a few concerning the local area.

1: Public Nuisance.

A licence for Rownhams house will lead to multiple vehicles (private and taxis) arriving and leaving at unsociable hours, which will obviously be magnified during the summer when people need to leave their windows open. Rownhams house is hidden within the local housing so this will potentially wake people up and cause the nuisance.
