Please give a general description of the premises (please read guidance note 1)

This is an application for a new Premises Licence for a greenfield site which is part of the Adanac Park Business Park development. The Business Park is in the process of construction and presently houses the Ordnance Survey head office and is to include a Lidl distribution centre together with other developments.

It is intended that the proposed premises will operate as a food lead pub restaurant providing much needed amenity to the Business Park under the Farmhouse Inns (formerly Cloverleaf) brand with car park. In addition to the usual food and beverage provision associated with premises such as this, it will provide very limited occasional regulated entertainment. It is planned that there should be of the order of 300 covers. External areas are to be included within the licensed area for the purpose of sale by retail of alcohol and late night refreshment only. Off sales are to be permitted.

The details of the development are shown on the drawings identified below, deposited with this application in respect of which an application for Planning Permission is ongoing.

It is proposed that the permitted hours for licensable activities for these premises should be :-

Monday to Sunday: 10:00 - 00:30 inclusive with the premises closing to the general public 30 minutes thereafter.

This application seeks to licence the premises specifically to authorise under the Licensing Act 2003 the following activities:

- Occasional regulated entertainment comprising: Live music and amplified voice, recorded music by music systems and similar forms of entertainment.
- 2. The sale of alcohol and such regulated entertainment as specified in the appropriate boxes below.
- 3. The provision of late night refreshment after 23.00

The appropriate drawings deposited with this application are:

- Site location plan drawing no. 2815/82 which includes a Google Earth image identifying the location of the site.
- Licensing drawing drawing no. 2815-81 identifying the internal and external areas to be licensed.
- First Floor plan drawing no. 2815-83 identifying the first floor Manager's accommodation.

The applicant operates a number of Farmhouse Inn Pub Restaurants as community food lead outlets. They are not known to be associated with problems of crime and disorder.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

No further risks have been identified which need to be addressed, save as below

The use of doorstaff will be risk assessed on an ongoing basis by the licence holder of premises

supervisor. Where engaged, door staff shall be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.

- Alcoholic and other drinks may not be removed from the premises in open containers save for consumption in any external area provided for that purpose.
- Staff will receive training on matters concerning underage sales, drugs policies and operating procedures.
- 4. There shall be a zero tolerance policy in relation to drugs at the premises and there shall be regular checks by management to prevent the use of drugs by patrons. Drugs seized shall be stored securely and handed to the police.
- 5. The premises shall operate a proof of age scheme and will require photographic identification from any person who appears to be under the age of 21 years.
- 6. The management of the premises will liaise with police on issues of local concern or disorder,
- 7. CCTV will be installed with recording facilities such recordings shall be retained for a period of 31 days and made available within a reasonable time upon request by the police, such as to cover the main entrance to the premises.
- 8. There shall be no drinks promotions at the premises which are inconsistent with the need to promote responsible drinking.

c) Public safety

No further risks have been identified which need to be addressed, save as below

- 1. To comply with the reasonable requirements of the fire officer from time to time.
- 2. Staff will be trained on matters of safety, evacuation and use of emergency equipment as required.
- 3. Spillages and breakages will be removed as soon as possible to reduce the risk to patrons and staff.
- 4. Toughened glasses will be used in the premises where appropriate.
- 5. Fire Exits and means of escape shall be kept clear and in good operational condition.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

No further risks have been identified which need to be addressed, save as below

- Where appropriate, prominent, clear and legible notices shall be displayed at all exits requesting the public respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and area quietly.
- Patrons will be encouraged by staff to leave quietly and respect the interests of the occupiers of any nearby noise sensitive premises, Where appropriate the licensee or a suitable staff member will monitor patrons leaving at the closing time.
- Noise or vibration shall not emanate from the premises so as to cause a nuisance to nearby properties.
- 4. Contact numbers for local taxi firm(s) shall be kept at the premises and made available to patrons requiring a taxi.

e) The protection of children from harm

- 1) The restrictions set out in the Licensing Act 2003 will apply. No unusual or additional risks of harm to children have been identified.
- 2) No films or videos of any description will be shown so that they can be viewed by persons under the age of any applicable BBFC/Local Authority certification.
- 3) Children under the age of 16 shall not be permitted to enter the premises after 21:00 unless dining with an adult or attending a pre booked function or resident in any adjacent hotel.
- 4) There shall be adequate controls in place including staff training to safeguard against the sale of alcohol to persons under 18 years.
- 5) The premises supervisor or appointed staff member shall ensure that when children are admitted to the premises their presence is not inconsistent with the style of operation of the premises at that time and the licensable activities that are being carried out.
