Further to the application for a dance and alcohol licence and extended hours at Frankie's Fun Factory Ltd Unit 3 on the Romsey Industrial Estate, Romsey, SO51 0HR.

My objections to the above schemes is

1. The playing of recorded music does already happen. This usually ends around 20-00 hours when there is a children's function taking place.

The bass can be heard clearly when sat at home at 6 Budds Lane with the double glazed windows and doors closed.

The Unit 3 was built as a warehouse/factory unit and is acoustically unsound. This allows the noise to permeate through the corrugated metal roof, reinforced glass windows above the brick work and the extract vents installed in the brick work.

The above building defects and the extended hours will no doubt cause a public nuisance for the adjacent residents in Budds Lane and Great Bridge Road if the licence for recorded music is granted.

Remedial works for the acoustic breakout should, if undertaken be completed and tested to ensure that there is no audible break out before this application is considered.

2. Why is there any requirement for the selling of alcohol on the premises? This is a children's facility!

To grant this alcohol licence and extend the opening hours will influence the children using the premises and cause a public nuisance, crime and disorder and public safety factors for the adjacent residents in Budds Lane and Great bridge road when guest's leave the premises at 11-00pm and later.
