## 280 <u>Licensing Act 2003 – Yellow Card and Red Card Approach to</u> the Review of Premises Licences

The Committee considered a report which concerned the Department of Culture, Media and Sport (DCMS) and Home Office recommendations for a "yellow card" and "red card" approach to the review of premises licences issued under the Licensing Act 2003.

The Licensing Manager explained that the yellow card would be the application of tough license conditions with the threat of revocation (a red card) at a further review should the premises fail to improve. The proposals resulted from the DCMS review of the Licensing Act in March 2008 and were endorsed by the National Audit Office report "The Home Office – Reducing the risk of violent crime".

The Licensing Manager confirmed that all reviews of premises licences would continue to be considered by a Licensing Sub-Committee on an individual basis. The Sub-committee would be responsible for imposing the yellow card and the length of time which the premises was required to display it.

The Committee supported the proposals and requested that there should be a standard size and format for the card, which should be displayed in a prominent position at the premises.

### Resolved:

That the Committee adopt the recommendations for a 'yellow card' and 'red card' approach to the Review of Premises Licences.
