Revocation of a Private Hire Vehicle Driver's Licence

Consideration was given to a report of the Head of Administration which informed the Committee that the Head of Administration had revoked a Private Hire Vehicle Driver's Licence under delegated powers.

A Private Hire Vehicle driver had failed to disclose a criminal conviction for theft and it is the Council's policy to revoke a licence if a driver is convicted of any offence involving dishonesty. The applicant had been advised of the right to appeal to the Magistrates Court against the Council's decision provided it was within 21 days of receiving notification from the Council. No appeal notice was lodged.

The matter was reported to the Committee for information only to ensure that the Council's scheme of delegation was complied with. The Licensing Manager stressed that it was important for Members to be made aware of such revocations and the reasons why the decision was taken.
