NOTES:

- 1.0 All planting & landscape operations to comply with Landscape Specification, BS4482(2/1989)
"Recommendations for General Landscape Operations" and BS3936 Pt 1 (1992) "Specification for Nursery Stock: Trees and Shrubs". All container sizes shown are minimums acceptable – all plants to be supplied to sizes indicated.
- 2.0 All ornamental shrubs to be planted at regular spacings in rows set diagonally to the edge of the bed.
- 3.0 All ornamental shrub beds and hedges to be provided with coarse grade bark mulch minimum 75mm deep.
- 4.0 PLANTS NOT SUPPLIED TO THE HEIGHTS INDICATED WILL BE REJECTED – CONTAINER SIZES ARE A GUIDE ONLY AND SHOULD NOT BE USED AS THE BASIS FOR ORDERING STOCK FROM SUPPLIERS. THE CONTRACTOR IS TO ENSURE THAT ALL PLANTS ARE TO THE HEIGHTS SPECIFIED.
- 5.0 Drawing based on Architects Site Layout Plan
- 6.0 Topsoil to be 450mm deep in all shrub areas, 100mm deep in all grass areas. Tree pits to be 750 x 750 x 500mm filled with topsoil.
- 7.0 All grass areas to be turfed using Premium quality lawn turf.
- 8.0 PROGRAMME
SCHEME TO BE IMPLEMENTED PRIOR TO THE OCCUPATION OF THE BUILDING.
- 9.0 Refer to construction drawings prepared by others, or consult with Contract Administrator, for details of paving layouts, alignment etc.
- 10.0 BOUNDARY TREATMENTS.
All boundaries to be left as is, unless shown otherwise.
