








# 34 Hadrian Way, Chilworth

Updated statement from Ian Lansley at Global Tree Care - 22/12/2020:

As can be seen in the topographical survey for 34 Hadrian Way rootzones for all the trees in the construction area have been shown. The only tree which would be of any concern is 02853. This is a mature Scots Pine with a full root protection area of 8 meters. The tree itself is in good health and shows no evidence of fungal invasion.

As can be seen the majority of this tree's rootzone extends into the woodland. Although there have been works close to this tree, the construction of a supporting wall and land build up, I can confirm the following.

There has been no damage to the rootzone from the building of the supporting wall. The construction of the wall has used an existing foundation which was already present. Following this the sloping back garden ground level has been raised and levelled. Looking at the plan there is some build up over the rootzone, however given the maturity and health of this tree I do not believe that this construction will have any detrimental effects to this tree.
