SUBJECT

The take back of redundant wheelie bins under the new collection arrangements is due to start on 27th February 2006. Council officers have been searching for a suitable affordable site to store these bins for several weeks without success. There is a possibility that the bins may be needed in the future and rather than send them for recycling which is expensive in itself it would be better to keep them in case they are needed. At the last minute a site has become available at Sandy Lane north of Romsey which can be let on licence or lease to the Council for the required period of two years at a rent of £16530 per annum plus business rates
