Changes to Portfolio Responsibilities

Report of the Leader

Recommended:

- 1. That the current Planning and Transport Portfolio be split into two portfolios; the Planning Policy and Transport Portfolio and the Planning and Building Portfolio, effective from 1 October 2015.
- 2. That the responsibility for Sustainability be moved from the Planning Policy and Transport Portfolio to the Environmental Portfolio.

SUMMARY:

- The Council operates a Leader and Cabinet model of governance under which, as required by the relevant legislation, all executive powers vest in the Leader.
- The Leader has authority to determine his own Cabinet and associated portfolios and portfolio responsibilities

1 Introduction

- 1.1 Test Valley Borough Council operates a Leader and Cabinet model as set out in the Local Government Act 2000. Under this model the Leader has authority to determine his own Cabinet and can change portfolios and portfolio responsibilities at a Leader's Decision Day.
- 1.2 Since the introduction of portfolios, the allocation of responsibilities has been altered on several occasions to reflect changes in the organisation's structure, provision of services and priorities (March 2005, July 2007, May 2009 and July 2011).
- 1.3 Currently there are seven Portfolios; Community and Leisure, Corporate, Corporate Management, Economic, Environmental, Housing and Environmental Health and Planning and Transport.
- 1.4 The current Planning and Transport Portfolio covers the responsibilities of two Council Services; Planning Policy and Transport and Planning and Building. It is proposed that the portfolio be split along service responsibilities to create two smaller, more focussed portfolios. It was specifically recognised that it will be vital for the two Portfolio Holders to work in particularly close co-operation with each other.

- 1.5 To establish the two portfolios, the responsibilities for Planning and Building would be moved into a new stand alone Planning and Building portfolio. The remaining responsibilities would be covered by the Planning Policy and Transport Portfolio.
- 1.6 The responsibility for Business Liaison in the South of the Borough would be retained by the Deputy Leader.
- 1.7 It is recommended that the responsibility for sustainability, which is currently within the Planning and Transport Portfolio, be moved to the Environmental Portfolio.
- 1.8 Changes to portfolio responsibilities can be seen in Annex 1.

2 Corporate Objectives and Priorities

2.1 The proposed changes to portfolio responsibilities reflect the Council's service structure.

3 Options

- 3.1 There are considered to be two options; continue with the current position of a single portfolio covering the responsibilities of both Planning Policy and Transport and Planning and Building or to split the current Portfolio to form two portfolios.
- 3.2 Option 1 This would maintain the status quo.
- 3.3 Option 2 This would result in two portfolios covering planning related responsibilities. One portfolio would cover the responsibilities of the Council's Planning Policy and Transport functions and the other would cover the responsibilities of the Council's Planning and Building functions.

4 **Resource Implications**

4.1 An additional portfolio holder will result in an increase in the Members' Budget in 2015/16 of £3,897 (£7,794 full year impact) to cover payment of their Special Responsibility Allowance, which will be met from contingencies.

6 Conclusion

6.1 The change to portfolio responsibilities would result in eight portfolios; Community and Leisure, Corporate, Corporate Management, Economic, Environmental, Housing and Environmental Health and Planning and Building and Planning Policy and Transport.
