



#### **Legend**

- 1. Entrance green** - Seeded grass area with new native tree planting, new legacy trees, retention of existing boundary trees and new entrance feature with ornamental shrubs
- 2. Activity lawn** - Formal lawn for informal recreation and activities, banked to one side including a legacy tree
- 3. Gardening club** - Raised allotment beds with seating, fruit trees and a shed
- 4. Central green** - Retained existing Oak trees complemented with new tree planting. Existing tarmac removed and area topsoiled to create a long grass meadow
- 5. Monk's Brook corridor** - Existing trees removed and replaced with new, native tree planting. Beneath the trees will be swathes of native shrubs within a wildflower meadow
- 6. Oak tree gardens** - Formal lawns with ornamental planting and seating focused on a legacy tree
- 7. Ecological buffer** - A continuous green corridor along the stream and woodland edge consisting of a wildflower meadow with native shrub and tree planting and incorporating a new pond
